She was hypotensive this afternoon and we held diuretics for now. Once her blood pressure improved, we have restarted Lasix gtt. at 20 mg/h. However, her blood pressure was trending down and we have reduced her Lasix dosing to 10 mg/h. She remains on epinephrine gtt. at 5 mcg/min. Plan for 1 unit PRBC transfusion tomorrow, if hemoglobin continues to trend down. Overall, her options are very limited and she was deemed not a good candidate for dialysis or for MCS. It would be reasonable to proceed with goals of care discussion. However, patient does not feel ready at this time. I have had multiple discussions with patient and her husband today regarding this. I have requested that they discuss amongst themselves and consider palliative care involvement.

Continue epinephrine gtt. at 5 mcg/min and Lasix gtt. at 10 mg/h.
Unfortunately, her creatinine continues to trend up.
