**Assessment - virtual consult:**

Chart and photos reviewed. 66 y.o. female with MASD to medial buttocks, gluteal cleft, and sacrum. Area is red with small fissure in gluteal cleft. Periwound clean, intact.



**Recommendation:**

Cleanse with Vashe, apply thin layer of Triad paste and leave open to air. Reapply Triad paste as needed to maintain thin layer. Wound care will sign off. Please re-consult if needs arise.
